- All entries should be posted no later than March 30, 2012 and should include a stamped, self-addressed envelope for the return of your work.
- An entry form needs to be included with each entry.
- Your work must be available for exhibition from April through to Nov 2012, as selected entries may be displayed at Craft & Quilt Fairs and possibly other craft events organised by Expertise Events. Please see "Copyright & Moral Rights" below.
